# TOUR I - TASTE OF ISRAEL TOUR - 5 DAYS/4 NIGHTS

## DAY 1 - Arrival

Airport meeting assistance and transfer to Jerusalem hotel.

## DAY 2 - Jerusalem: Old & New

Explore the biblical and cultural highlights of Old and New Jerusalem. Start the tour with a panoramic view of the city from Mount of Olives. Explore the restored Jewish Quarter and visit the Cardo, an ancient Roman marketplace where you can still shop today. Stop at the Western Wall. Continue into the Christian Quarter and walk along the Via Dolorosa, following the Stations of the Cross to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Continue in the afternoon for a moving visit to Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial. (On Saturdays visit Garden of Gethsemane and/or Mt. Zion to see the Room of the Last Supper and the Tomb of King David in place of Yad Vashem)

Please note – Mount of Olives may be replaced by Mount Scopus

## DAY 3 - Masada & The Dead Sea

Depart Jerusalem and descend to the lowest place on earth. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to the rock fortress of Masada. Visit Herod's palaces, dating back 2000 years. Then hear about the zealots who defied the Roman Empire from this location. Enjoy a chance to swim in the Dead Sea. The water is so rich in salts and minerals that you float!

## DAY 4 - Nazareth & The Sea of Galilee

Early morning departure north to Nazareth, to see the town of Joseph and Mary. Visit the Church of the Annunciation. Continue to the Sea of Galilee via Cana to visit the ruins at Capernaum. Stop at Tabgha, where the Miracle of the Fishes and Loaves took place. Return via the Baptismal site at Yardenit.

## DAY 5 - Departure

Transfer to airport for departure.

Visit the Tomb of King David and the room of the Last Supper on Mount Zion. Enter the walled city and walk through the newly restored Jewish Quarter. Visit the Roman Cardo, the Herodian Quarter and continue to the Western Wall. Walk along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Proceed to Mount Scopus and then to the Mount of Olives for a magnificent panoramic view of the Old City. Continue to Bethlehem\*, stopping at Rachel's Tomb and to visit the Church of the Nativity.  
Overnight in Jerusalem.



## THURSDAY - Jerusalem: The New City

Drive to the Hadassah Medical Center in Ein Kerem to see the Chagall stained glass windows. Continue to Yad Vashem, the memorial to the Holocaust and then to the Israel Museum; visit the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are housed and the miniature model of Jerusalem as it was during the Second Temple period. View the Knesset, Israel's Parliament, and the Givat Ram Campus of the Hebrew University. Overnight in Jerusalem.

## FRIDAY - Qumeran / Massada / Dead Sea

Drive through the Judean Desert to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth, almost 1300 feet (400 meters) below sea level. Stop at Qumeran to visit the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to Massada. Ascend by cable car and tour the ancient fortress where the Zealots made their last stand against the Romans before committing mass suicide in 73 AD. Descend by cable car; time and weather permitting, an opportunity will be provided to float on the Dead Sea.  
Overnight in Tel Aviv.

## SUNDAY - Diaspora Museum

/ Caesarea / Druze villages

Depart Tel Aviv and drive to the Diaspora Museum for a visit. Proceed along the coastal plain to Caesarea, capital of Judea under the Romans. See the excavations of the Crusader city and the Roman port, aqueduct and the amphitheatre that has been restored to its former glory as a concert venue. Continue via the Druze villages to Haifa.  
Overnight in Haifa.

## MONDAY - Haifa / Safed / Golan Heights

The tour of Haifa will begin at the summit of Mount Carmel where you will take in a breathtaking panoramic view of the Haifa Bay and Western Galilee. Continue on to the golden domed Bahai Shrine to visit the exotic Persian Gardens. Proceed to Safed, the centre of Jewish mysticism, where you will visit the ancient synagogues and the artists' colony. Continue to the Golan Heights to see the former Syrian bunkers, Kuneitra and the new Israeli town of Katzrin.  
Overnight in Kibbutz.

## TUESDAY - Sea of Galilee / Nazareth

Start the day with a visit of Tiberias. Drive to Capernaum to see the ruins of the synagogue and octagonal church of St. Peter and then proceed to Nazareth. Here you will visit the church of the Annunciation. Drive via Beit Shean to Beit Alpha to see the remains of the mosaic floor of an ancient synagogue depicting the zodiac.  
Overnight in Tel Aviv.

## WEDNESDAY - Departure

After breakfast, transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for departure.

Drive to Haifa; view the Persian Gardens at the Bahai Temple. From Haifa, drive to Acre to visit the ancient city and harbor.

Continue to Kibbutz Lavi for dinner and overnight.

## TUESDAY - Tiberias / Capernaum / Banias

After a short tour of Tiberias, we take a boat ride to Capernaum. Visit the remains of the 2nd century synagogue. Proceed to Tabgha, the site of the miracle of fish and loaves, and visit the Church of Multiplication with its 4th century mosaic floor. Continue to Mount of the Beatitudes, the place where Jesus delivered the Sermon on the Mount. Drive to the Banias Springs and Waterfall and tour the Golan Heights.

Return to Kibbutz Lavi for dinner and overnight.

## WEDNESDAY - Nazareth / Beit Shean

Drive to Nazareth via Cana of Galilee. In Nazareth, visit the Church of the Annunciation, St. Joseph's Workshop and Mary's Well. Drive to Yardenit, the baptismal site on the Jordan River. Continue to Beit Shean, a newly excavated city, and visit the Roman theatre. Drive along the Jordan River to Jerusalem for overnight.

Overnight in Jerusalem.

## SATURDAY - Dead Sea - Massada

Drive to Qumeran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found. Visit the ancient city of Qumeran and drive along the shore of the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth, to Massada, the last stronghold of the Jews after the destruction of the Second Temple in 73 A.D. Ascend Massada by cable car and visit the food storeroom, water irrigation system and Herod's Palace. Descend by cable car. Time and weather permitting, an opportunity will be provided to float on the Dead Sea.

Return to Jerusalem for overnight.

## SUNDAY - Departure

Transfer to Ben Gurion airport for departure.

Take an opportunity to renew wedding vows at the Cana church where Jesus turned water into wine. Visit the site of the transfiguration at Mount Tabor. Overnight: Nazareth (B, D)

### DAY 4 - Sea of Galilee

Experience mass on a morning sail across the Sea of Galilee. See the remains of a boat from the time of Jesus. Visit Tabgha, where Jesus multiplied five loaves and two fish. Enjoy a traditional St. Peters Fish Lunch (lunch not included). Continue onto Capernaum, the center of Jesus' Ministries. Ascend to the top of the Mt. of Beatitudes, where you can relive the Sermon on the Mount. Stop at Korazim to see the ancient city hewn from basalt rock. Overnight: Nazareth (B, D)

### DAY 5 - Jordan Valley

Visit the baptism site at Yardenit. Stop at the Roman city of Beith Shean. Enjoy an overview of the ancient city of Jericho. Ascend the mountains to the holy city of Jerusalem. Overnight: Jerusalem (B, D)

### DAY 6 - Jerusalem

Start with a spectacular view of Jerusalem from Mt. of Olives. Visit the Church of Pater Noster and the Chapel of Ascension. Walk down the Palm Sunday Road to see the Church of Dominus Flevit and the Church of all Nations at the Garden of Gethsemane. See the Pools of Bethesda and St. Anne's Church. Pass through Ecce Homo Arch to the Via Dolorosa and visit each Station of the Cross to the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Overnight: Jerusalem (B, D)

### DAY 7 - Bethlehem

Onto Mount Zion to visit the Room of the Last Supper and King David's tomb. See the dungeon where Jesus was imprisoned at the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Continue on for a visit to the Abbey. Celebrate Mass before visiting the fascinating village of Ein Kerem and the birthplace of John the Baptist. Afternoon visit to Bethlehem and the Church of the Nativity (subject to security clearance). Overnight: Jerusalem (B, D)

### DAY 8 - Dead Sea

Depart Jerusalem via the Inn of the Good Samaritan. Visit the caves of Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered - Ascend the mighty fortress of Masada. Experience a 'float' in the salty waters of the Dead Sea.

Overnight: Jerusalem (B, D)

See the Marc Chagall stained glass windows at the Hadassah medical center, and visit Ein Karem where John the Baptist was born. Overnight: Jerusalem

## WEDNESDAY - Jerusalem: Old City & Bethlehem

Visit the Western Wall and the Temple Mount (subject to security clearance). Explore the colourful bazaars, and walk the Via Dolorosa (Stations of the Cross) until the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Continue to Bethlehem (subject to security clearance) to visit Rachel's Tomb and the Church of the Nativity. Overnight: Jerusalem

## THURSDAY - Sea of Galilee

Depart Jerusalem via Jericho (subject to security clearance), the oldest city in the world. Explore the excavations of the beautiful Roman City of Beit Shean. Proceed to Tiberias, and drive along the shores of the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum to visit the ruins of the ancient synagogue. Overnight: Galilee Kibbutz hotel

## FRIDAY - Upper Galilee

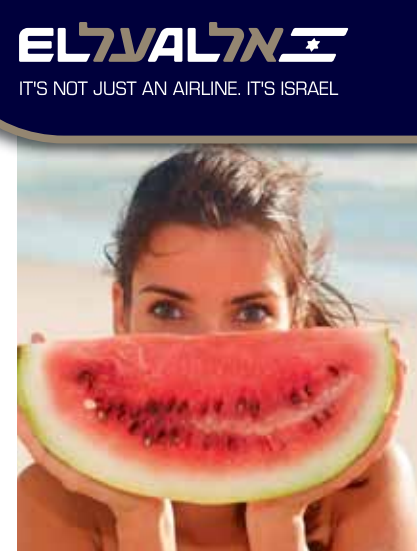
